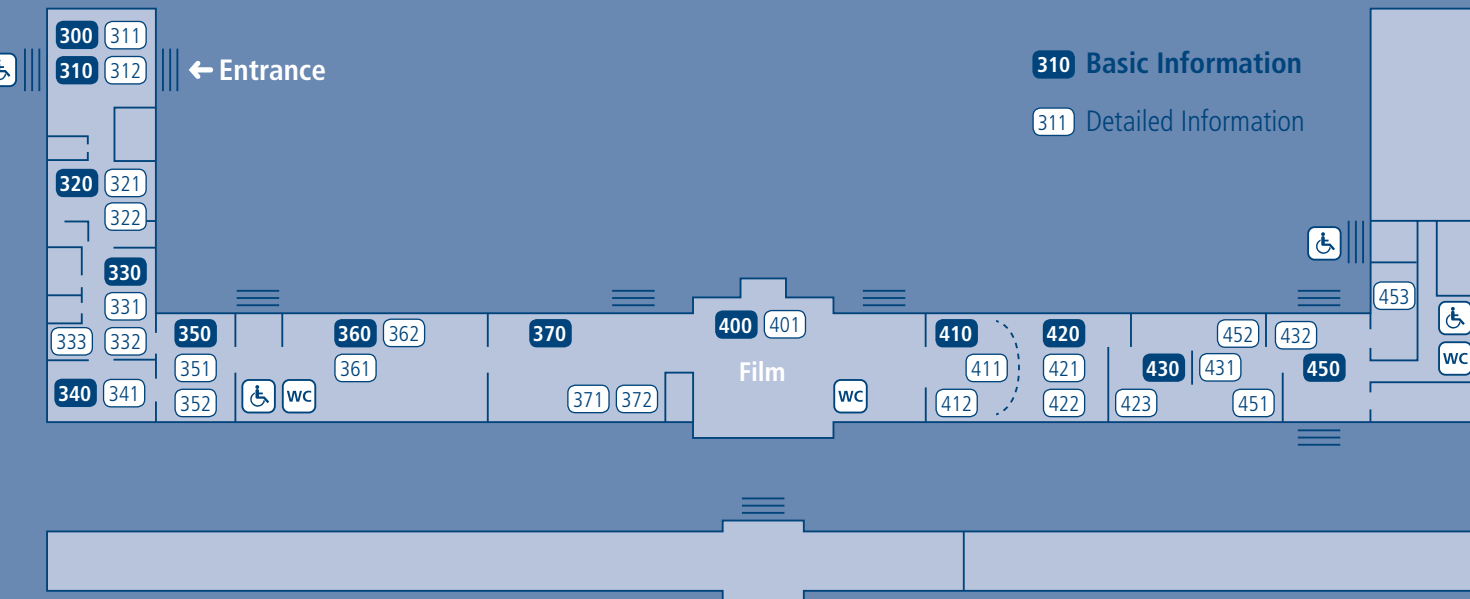


# Museum
